

Community Code

No Anti-Social Behaviour or Offensive Language

Anyone using violent, aggressive or disruptive behaviour or language will not be allowed into the shelter; even if they have been booked in.

No Illegal Drugs

Illegal drug use or possession will result in a permanent ban. We cannot take responsibility for any prescription drugs during your stay.

No Alcohol

This is NOT a wet shelter. You cannot consume alcohol inside or immediately outside the shelter. Please do not turn up drunk or with alcohol on you. Unopened alcohol will not be allowed onto the premises.

No Smoking inside the Shelter

Smoking inside the shelter is not permitted. Guests will be able to have a cigarette in a smoking area outside the shelter.

No Weapons

No weapons of any kind will be permitted in the shelter. Possession of weapons will result in a permanent ban.

The dignity and safety of our guests and volunteers is *very* important to us. Failure to meet these conditions will result in a warning.

Two warnings or a serious incident will result in a permanent ban from the shelter.

It is not our intention to exclude anyone. However, if guests cannot respect these conditions we will have to take appropriate action
